As part of our initial effort, we ask you to fill out the enclosed questionnaire. At the top of the page is a section to update up to three contact numbers and related information for your business. This will help us make contact with the proper authority should a concern arise at your location. We are updating our Department software system in the coming months. Having the current information will be critical in building the data base for the exchange of information and services.

We also ask that you take some time to fill out the space provided for comments and insight on how the Southborough Police Department can be of greater service. Feel free to continue comments on the back of the page. **Please return the survey in the provided self-addressed stamped envelope.**

In the coming weeks, your business or organization will be contacted by an Officer who will be assigned as your liaison on a permanent basis. The Officer will provide a card with contact information and check in at pre-determined intervals. We look forward to a mutual partnership that will work for the benefit of all involved as we grow our service based Community Policing philosophies to the business sector.

This initiative is not meant to replace normal procedures for police assistance. If you encounter an emergency situation, want to report a crime or suspicious activity, you should contact the Southborough Dispatch Center who will direct an Officer to handle the situation.
